Play Facilities

Meadow Vale Open Space is the best location for a childrens play area as this would fill the gap in provision especially in an area with a high concentration of families.

Rodney Road playing fields and Plummers Hill Open Space are not suitable locations for childrens play areas.

Upgrade of Colebrook Road Open Space childrens play area will be needed.

PRIORITIES

Casual Green Spaces – Hudds Vale, Plummers Hill & Rodney Road Playing Fields

- 1. Benches, bins & signage
- 2. Improve entrances particularly accessibility eg kissing gates
- 3. Maintain and improve boundaries
- 4. Regular maintenance

Meadow Vale Open Space

- 1. Most suitable location for a childrens play area in close proximity to day nursery
- 2. Teenage facilities on hard standing eg skate park (further consultation required)
- 3. Seating & litter bins
- 4. Tree planting/community garden with sensory plants
- 5. Higher entrances to prevent motorbike access

Specific points raised:

- Explore recycling collection points on entrance to Plummers Hill eg plastic
- Pedestrian access from Cecil Avenue to Plummers Hill to be explored
- Explore options of disused building with landowner on Plummers Hill
- Improved lighting on Rodney Road should be explored
- Retain hedge along Rodney Road and road widening not needed

Primrose Lane Open Space – further consultation required as nobody present to put forward priorities at meeting.
