- We need play equipment for girls where they can play and chat, the boys who play on the fields have consistently asked for goal posts when asked and do not care if it gets a bit muddy
- Comments on there being no or a inadequate play area (5 people)
- Very poor drainage, a filed that gets extremely muddy
- Too many bikes, dogs on the loose and dog mess
- It will have to be rustic to keep with the fell of the hill and very vandal proof as the last attempt at a play area was ruined
- Provide play equipment in another area that is less likely to be vandalised. Do not consider £10 000 enough money, if the majority want play equipment section 106 money should be used & mobilise friends of troopers hill to apply for grants
- Over time it becomes dilapidated and provides very little amusement.
- It was lovely but got vandalised to such an extent that it became unusable and eventually there really was nothing left
