VARIOUS ROADS, TROOPERS' HILL ROAD AREA, ST. GEORGE TROOPERS HILL WARD, PROHIBITION OF WAITING - TRAFFIC ORDERS

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE it proposes to make the following traffic orders:-

- A. Ref No. CAE/NMT/P-1014A** – the City Council of Bristol (Various Roads, Troopers' Hill Road, St. George Troopers Hill Ward, City of Bristol) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 20--, the effect of which would be:-
1. to introduce prohibition of waiting arrangements for vehicles in **Cassey Bottom Lane, Crew's Hole Road, Greendown, Kennion Road, Parfitts Hill, Rear Access Troopers' Hill Road** and **Widcombe Close**; and
 2. to revise prohibition of waiting arrangements for vehicles in **Troopers' Hill Road**.
- B. Ref No. CAE/NMT/P-1014B** – the City Council of Bristol (Various Roads, Kingsway Area, St. George Central, St. George Troopers Hill and St. George West Wards, City of Bristol) (General Traffic Regulation) Order 20--, the effect of which would be to revoke the City Council of Bristol (Various Roads, Kingsway Area, St. George East and St. George West Wards, City of Bristol) (General Traffic Regulation) Order 2014, as varied, so as:-
1. to transfer Troopers' Hill Road waiting provisions to be regulated by the proposal order at item A; and
 2. to revise prohibition of waiting arrangements for vehicles in **Harcourt Avenue**.

All other 2014 order provisions would be brought forward unamended.
